

### **Meeting held on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2020.**

We have 40 teams registered to play in the 2020/21 season.

The league set-up will be 'A' Division 14 teams, 'B' & 'C' Divisions 13 teams each.

If permitted, the league will start on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> October 2020 with a two week break over the Christmas period and finish on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2021.

If we are not allowed to start in October, we could set-up the league in four divisions of 10 teams in each, this means we would not need to start until Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> December 2020 with a two week break over the Christmas period and would finish on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2021. If this option is used the league positions for teams when we stopped playing the 2019/20 season, will be used for the start of 2021/22 season.

Currently, we are not going to organise any competition matches, but this can be reviewed if the situation improves.

### **On match night.**

Given the changing situation we are in, we would like to think that teams will do all they can to comply with the social distancing measures that are in place when we are permitted to start, this will also include any measures that the venues have in place as well.

We recommend that teams take their own hand sanitising wipes/gel and a cloth for the balls.

For the stickers, teams will provide them with gloves to wear. If social distancing measures are required, we suggest that they stick up on their own when the opposition is playing, and stand with their own team when they are playing.

Given that this may increase the time required to play the match we should ensure that all matches start at 8:15 pm.

We recommend that Score cards are completed by one member of the **home team only** throughout the match, away team to supply a list of player's names for the card.

### **Food.**

The provision of food will be controlled by the home venue as they may well be operating on minimum staff levels, which means they may not have the ability/time to prepare and serve food. Home teams are to inform the visiting teams what is happening at their venue prior to the match.

Would all team captains ensure that their players are aware of the content of this memo.
